Flights:

The air flights have now been booked. The main party will be flying out of London Heathrow on Friday 17th July 2009 at 22.00 on a Kenyan Airways flight to Lusaka via Nairobi. The return flight for the majority of the party will be at 12.45 on Saturday 8th August 2009 arriving back at London Heathrow in the early hours of Sunday morning. Travel by coach will be arranged between

the Northeast and Heathrow the timing of which still has to be arranged but we have to be at Heathrow by 17.00. The four member of the party who requested an extension to their trip will return on **Friday 14th August** 2009 arriving at London Heathrow early on the Saturday morning. (Flights were not available for return trip on the Saturday or Sunday due to part of the flight being fully booked).

Deposits
